### RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, Lake County's Risk Management Department is preparing an ADA Transition Plan to comply with current federal and state ADA regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division of Transportation (DOT) will complete an inventory of existing curb ramp locations throughout the County's right-of-way as part of this work; and

WHEREAS, DOT employees collected data on approximately 600 locations during the winter of 2017-2018; and

**WHEREAS**, DOT desires to complete the remaining data collection on approximately 3,000 locations; and

**WHEREAS**, it is advisable that a consultant engineering firm be employed to provide said engineering services; and
